RULES

- SOBHD rules will be followed.
- Last to enter, first to dance.
- Age division will be determined in accordance with the number of entrants in each classification.
- **All dancers must have a valid FUSTA or Scotdance registration number to enter. A valid 2012 Card required. All dancers without their valid registration cards must provide a copy of the card to the organizer within 10 days regardless of whether they won any awards.**
- Communication by a dancer or parent of a dancer with the judge or piper is grounds for disqualification.
- All dance competitors and teachers and parents are expected to comply with the FUSTA Code of Ethics.
- Any dancer not in line when their event takes place will forfeit their entry in that event.
- Absolutely no field entries will be accepted.
- Late entries accepted until 3/22/2012.
- Dancers must remain in costume to receive awards.
- The Competition Committee reserves the right to change any event or time schedule.
- Medals awarded for 1st/2nd/3rd place winners in Pre-Premier. Ribbons awarded for 4th/5th/6th place winners in Pre-Premier and Premier.
- Premier Prize money: 16/over: 1st, \$60; 2nd, \$50; 3rd, \$40. 15/under: 1st, \$40; 2nd, \$30; 3rd, \$20. (Award money may change and be determined by the total number of premier dancers and groups)
- An Arizona Beginner, Novice, Intermediate & Premier Dancer Trophy (sponsored by Daughters of Scotia, Desert Thistle Lodge #260) will be awarded to each group based on a dance-off. Must be a resident of Arizona.
- Aggregate Trophy will be awarded when appropriate to the dancer in their classification and age group with the highest points.
Please videotape and photograph only your dancer, if other dancers are in the frame those dancers need your permission.
