When Bill isn't teaching, judging or piping for Highland dancing, he works at Central Michigan University as a Certified Athletic Trainer rehabilitating injured employees of the University and as a Certified Ergonomics Specialist. Bill is a member of the S.O.B.H.D. Worldwide Judges panel as well as a Life member of the B.A.T.D. in both Highland and National dances. Bill has a small, but very successful dance school he runs with his wife, Liz, in St. Louis, Michigan. His students have won numerous Championships and are consistently very successful in many major Championships including the USIR, Canadian Inter-Provincial Championships, North American Championships and World Championships. He has been the Midwest's Representative to FUSTA four times and is presently the FUSTA Immediate Past President. Besides teaching and judging Scottish dancing, Bill has developed a very popular training program for Highland dancers to help increase their strength and explosiveness and is also a popular piper for Scottish dancing competitions. In addition, Bill is also a co-organizer of the highly popular World of Highland Dancing Conference held every three years in Las Vegas.

RULES

- SOBHD rules will be followed.
- Last to enter first to dance.
- Age division will be determined in accordance with the number of entrants.
- **All dancers must have a valid FUSTA or Scotdance registration number to enter. A valid 2008 Card required to receive awards.**
- Communication by a dancer or parent of a dancer with the judge or piper is grounds for disqualification.
- All dance competitors and teachers are expected to comply with the FUSTA Code of Ethics.
- Any dancer not on hand when their event takes place will forfeit their entry in that event.
- Absolutely no field entries will be accepted.
- Late entries accepted until 2/20/08.
- Dancers must remain in costume to receive awards.
- The Competition Committee reserves the right to change any event or time schedule.
- All dances count toward aggregate trophies.
- Medals awarded for 1st/2nd/3rd place winners in Pre-Premier. Ribbons awarded for 4th/5th/6th place winners in Pre-Premier and Premier.
- Premier Prize money: 16/over: 1st, \$50; 2nd, \$40; 3rd, \$30. 15/under: 1st, \$30; 2nd, \$20; 3rd, \$10.
- An Arizona Beginner, Novice, Intermediate & Premier Dancer Trophy (sponsored by Daughters of Scotia, Desert Thistle Lodge #260) will be awarded to each group based on a dance off. Must be a resident of Arizona.
- Aggregate Trophy will be awarded to the dancer in their classification and age group with the highest points.
- To attend Sunday workshop dancers must compete in Saturday events.
