She has been teaching at her own school of highland dancing in Toronto for the past 30 years and has produced many dancers of high caliber who have captured titles in various championships including the Ontario, Canadian, Scottish, Commonwealth and World Championships. There have been over 20 Canadian Championship Titles, many Scottish and Commonwealth Championship titles and runner-ups, and a World Champion who holds 10 World Titles.

She is a Fellow and Examiner of the B.A.T.D., North American Coordinator of the B.A.T.D., and adjudicator on the S.O.B.H.D. Judges panel. Joy teaches annually at the Ohio Scottish Arts School which is a week camp in June, the Delco Workshop in February and travels across Canada, United States, Scotland, Australia and New Zealand, judging, examining and conducting workshops.

- Last to enter, first to dance.
- Age division will be determined in accordance with the number of entrants in each classification..
- **All dancers must have a valid FUSTA or Scotdance registration number to enter. A valid 2010 Card required to receive awards.**
- Communication by a dancer or parent of a dancer with the judge or piper is grounds for disqualification.
- All dance competitors and teachers and parents are expected to comply with the FUSTA Code of Ethics.
- Any dancer not in line when their event takes place will forfeit their entry in that event.
- Absolutely no field entries will be accepted.
- Late entries accepted until 2/20/2010.
- Dancers must remain in costume to receive awards.
- The Competition Committee reserves the right to change any event or time schedule.
- Medals awarded for 1st/2nd/3rd place winners in Pre-Premier. Ribbons awarded for 4th/5th/6th place winners in Pre-Premier and Premier.
- Premier Prize money: 16/over: 1st, \$50; 2nd, \$40; 3rd, \$30. 15/under: 1st, \$30; 2nd, \$20; 3rd, \$10.
- An Arizona Beginner, Novice, Intermediate & Premier Dancer Trophy (sponsored by Daughters of Scotia, Desert Thistle Lodge #260) will be awarded to each group based on a dance-off. Must be a resident of Arizona.
- Aggregate Trophy will be awarded when appropriate to the dancer in their classification and age group with the highest points.
- **Teachers may participate in either workshop for a fee of \$15.00.**
- **Please videotape and photograph only your dancer, if other dancers are in the frame those dancers need your permission.**
