The Desert Southwest Grade IV Pipe Band Championship is hosted by the Arizona Scottish Gathering & Highland Games at Steele Indian School Park, Arizona. **Send completed form and \$30 entry fee (made payable to Caledonian Society of Arizona) to Kathy LeVar, 11413 E Ramona Avenue, Mesa, AZ 85212.** Entry forms must be received by February 1st 2010.

This is an open competition.

**COMPETITION RULES:** This is a WUSPBA sanctioned Grade IV Pipe Band Competition. Timed Medley competition will be on Saturday and Quick March Medley competition will be on Sunday.

**SIGN-IN AND TENT SPACE LOCATION:** All bands are to sign in with Kathy LeVar at the Chief Steward's tent upon arrival.

**ORDER OF PLAY AND TUNE LIST:** The Order of Play for each day will be determined by a drawing on the day of the event not less than two hours before the contest. You will be notified at that time. Each Band must submit a list of tunes they will be playing to Kathy LeVar at the above address.

**MASSED BANDS AND TRAVEL SUBSIDY:** There will be Massed Bands formations on Saturday (Opening Ceremonies) at 11:30AM and on Sunday (Closing Ceremonies) at 2:30PM. The subsidy is based on miles between a Band's home location and Phoenix, Arizona as follows: 0 to 200 miles - \$300, 201 to 500 miles - \$400, 501 to 800 miles - \$500, over 800 miles - \$600. Payment is contingent on the Band performing in both ceremonies and competing both days.

**PRIZES AND TROPHIES:** Cash prizes will be awarded each day: third place - \$150, second place - \$275, first place - \$550. Trophies will be presented during closing ceremonies.

**HOLD HARMLESS AGREEMENT:** The Organization named above (hereinafter called "The Band") hereby agrees for itself, the individual members, any successors and assignees thereof, to indemnify and hold harmless the Caledonian Society of Arizona from all claims, suits, or any other action for personal injuries, including death, and damages to property, real or personal, caused by The Band and/or acts or omissions of the Caledonian Society of Arizona arising out of The Band's involvement in the Arizona Scottish Gathering & Highland Games (hereinafter called "Games"), and from all judgments and costs incurred in relation to said claims and suits; and, from all expenses incurred in defending said claims or suits. The Band hereby releases the Caledonian Society of Arizona, all Sponsors and Officials, including their agents and employees, from liability including, but

not limited to, any claim for personal injury or physical impairment or other claim of any type arising out of participation or involvement in the Games. The Band also agrees to indemnify and hold harmless those released above from any such claims, damages, losses and expenses, including attorney's fees and all court costs.

**PHOTO RELEASE:** The undersigned does hereby give consent to the Caledonian Society of Arizona and assignees to take photographs, make audio recordings, and/or video recordings of The Band and/or any individual band member at the Arizona Scottish Gathering & Highland Games and to use such photographs, audio recordings, and/or video recordings for such promotion, publicity or other lawful purpose as the Caledonian Society of Arizona deems appropriate. The undersigned further waives any rights or claims as to content approval or damages that The Band and/or any individual band member may have for use of these reproductions.

**SAFETY AND SITE RULES:** Safety Rules and Regulations (and Vendor Safety Rules and Regulations, if applicable) apply to all individuals or organizations participating in the Arizona Scottish Gathering & Highland Games and must be adhered to. Copies are available for registered organizations.

1. **No** alcoholic beverages, firearms, or illegal drugs are permitted.
2. **No** vehicles are allowed on any field before, during, or after the event.

**SPECIAL PROCEDURES:**

1. All entrants to the facility will possess the proper ticket that is specified for that day.
2. Recreational vehicle camping space is available on a limited basis. Please email me if you need additional info.

**CITY OF PHOENIX & STATE OF ARIZONA SALES TAX LICENSES:** Licenses are required for all individuals/organizations selling merchandise or services unless said individual/organization is an IRS-approved tax-exempt nonprofit entity. You are responsible for providing proof of your tax-exempt status, upon request. All others are required to obtain necessary licenses, collect City of Phoenix and Arizona sales taxes, and file the forms with payment. Request forms, if need from the City of Phoenix.
