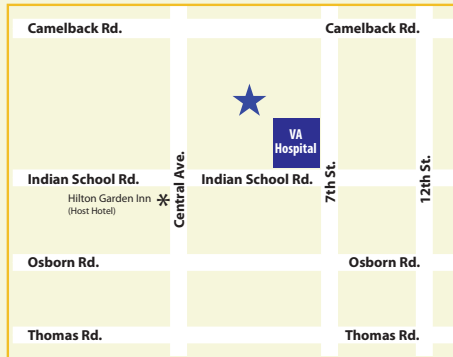

Angus & DidgeriDrew of Brother, Featuring guest percussionists – Two thirds of BROTHER, Angus and DidgeriDrew create a hypnotic sound together, both of them playing several different instruments during a show. Mesmerizing beats blend with didgeridoos, looped guitars and astral keyboards, inspiring listeners to dance and sing. Bagpipes, whistles and vocals weave captivating melodies in the BROTHER tradition, staying with audiences long after a show. The sound of Angus and DidgeriDrew is celtic tribal trance – and truly unique.



Tramor – Tramor (Overseas) is the new traditional music project of John Good. John is well known through out the West, South, Midwest and in his native Wales as a multi-instrumentalist, Welsh piper, singer/songwriter, composer and poet. Veteran of many Celtic festivals and concerts, including Estes Park, Chicago, San Diego and Denver, he brings the subtly different flavor of traditional Welsh music to the Phoenix stage. On this occasion he is aided and abetted by mandolin virtuoso Billy Parker... a duo not to be missed!



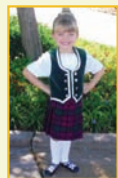
The Characters of Christopher Yates – Including Woody McCloud (as in "head in the...") Kilts on Stilts, and the Ten Foot Tall Scotsman!
